All: "Sell what you have, give that money to the poor." (Matt. 19:21)


One: Faith has always involved letting go, releasing, setting free, giving to others, and following.

All: In this time of worship, may we open our hearts, release that which binds us, and walk more freely with God.






Every seventh year you must cancel all debts. This is how the cancellation is to be handled: Creditors will forgive the loans of their fellow Israelites. They won't demand repayment from their neighbors or their relatives because the Lord's year of debt cancellation has been announced. You are allowed to demand payment from foreigners, but whatever is owed you from your fellow Israelites you must forgive. Of course there won't be any poor persons among you because the Lord will bless you in the land that the Lord your God is giving you to possess as an inheritance, but only if you carefully obey the Lord your God's voice,






by carefully doing every bit of this commandment that I'm giving you right now. Once the Lord your God has blessed you, exactly as God said, you will end up lending to many different peoples but won't need to borrow a thing. You will dominate many different peoples, but they won't dominate you.

Now if there are some poor persons among you, say one of your fellow Israelites in one of your cities in the land that the Lord your God is giving you, don't be hard-hearted or tightfisted toward your poor fellow Israelites.





To the contrary! Open your hand wide to them. You must generously lend them whatever they need. But watch yourself! Make sure no wicked thought crosses mind, such as, The seventh year is coming—the year of debt cancellation—so that you resent your poor fellow Israelites and don't give them anything. If you do that, they will cry out to the Lord against you, and you will be guilty of sin. No, give generously to needy persons. Don't resent giving to them because it is this very thing that will lead to the Lord your God's blessing you in all you do and work at.





Poor persons will never disappear from the earth. That's why I'm giving you this command: you must open your hand generously to your fellow Israelites, to the needy among you, and to the poor who live with you in your land.

Psalm 41:1-3, 9:18, 113:7-8, 146:5, 7-9 (NRSV)




One: Happy are those who consider the poor;

The Lord delivers them in the <u>day</u> of trouble.

All: The Lord protects them and keeps them alive; they are called happy <u>in</u> the land. You do not give them up to the will of their <u>en</u>emies.

One: For the needy shall not always <u>be</u> forgotten, Nor the hope of the poor pe<u>rish</u> forever.

All: God raises the poor from the dust, and lifts the needy <u>from</u> the ash heap, To make them sit with princes, with the princes <u>of</u> God's people.





One: Happy are those whose help is the <u>God</u> of Jacob, Whose hope is in the <u>Lord</u> their God,

All: who executes justice for <u>the</u> oppressed; Who gives food <u>to</u> the hungry.

One: The Lord lifts up those who <u>are</u> bowed down; The Lord <u>loves</u> the righteous.

All: The Lord watches <u>over</u> the strangers

And upholds the orphan and the widow, but the way of the wicked is <u>brought</u> to ruin.
