and in moments of celebration,


All: the Holy Spirit surrounds us.

Psalm 104:24-34, 35b

One: O Lord, how manifold <u>are</u> your works! In wisdom you have made them all; the earth is full <u>of</u> your creatures.

All: Yonder is the great and wide sea with its living things too many to number, creatures both small and great.

Psalm 104:24-34, 35b (continued)



One: There move the ships, and there is that Leviathan, which you have made for the sport of it.

All of them look to you to give them their food <u>in</u> due season.

All: You give it to them; they gather it; you open your hand, and they are <u>filled</u> with good things.

Psalm 104:24-34, 35b (continued)

One: You hide your face, and they are terrified;
you take away their breath,
and they die and return <u>to</u> their dust.
You send forth your Spirit, and they are created;
and so you renew the face <u>of</u> the earth.

All: May your glory, O Lord, endure forever; may you rejoice in <u>all</u> your works. You look at the earth and it trembles; you touch the mountains <u>and</u> they smoke.



Psalm 104:24-34, 35b (continued)

One: I will sing to the Lord as long as I live;
I will praise my God while I <u>have</u> my being.
May these words of mine please you;
I will rejoice <u>in</u> the Lord.

All: Bless the Lord, <u>O</u> my soul. Hal<u>le</u>lujah!

In life and in death we belong to God. Through the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit, we trust in the one triune God, the Holy One of Israel, whom alone we worship and serve.

In gratitude to God, empowered by the Spirit, we strive to serve Christ in our daily tasks and to live holy and joyful lives, even as we watch for God's new heaven and new earth, praying, "Come, Lord Jesus!"



With believers in every time and place, we rejoice that nothing in life or in death can separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.



Great Prayer of Thanksgiving



One: The Lord be with you.

All: And also with you.

One: Lift up your hearts.

On the night before he died,
